



ARMADILLO

The Armadillo is a robust communications and crisis management device that provides global vehicle tracking, text messaging and panic alerts. Armadillo is the mainstay product for security companies, governments, NGOs and reconstruction companies operating in hostile regions.

AS COMPANIES, NGOs AND GOVERNMENTS INCREASINGLY OPERATE IN DANGEROUS AND REMOTE PARTS OF THE WORLD, LOCATING ASSETS AND RESPONDING TO EMERGENCIES IS FAST BECOMING KEY TO EMPLOYEE SAFETY AND CORPORATE RISK MANAGEMENT.

USING A SATELLITE TRANSPONDER WITH AN INTEGRATED PANIC ALARM AND HANDHELD MESSAGING AND NAVIGATION DEVICE (PDA), THE ARMADILLO PROVIDES A RELIABLE GLOBAL SYSTEM CURRENTLY USED IN SOME OF THE MOST REMOTE AND DANGEROUS PARTS OF THE WORLD.

Armadillo is independent of local infrastructure and can operate anywhere in the world. The system is integrated into the Track24 C4i platform, allowing users access to all command, control, crisis management and GIS functions.

TRACKING

Armadillo sends regular position reports from 2 minute intervals upwards – this can be reconfigured remotely through the Track24 C4i platform.

PANIC ALARM

The panic alarm triggers a visual and audible alarm on the system in less than a minute. Alerts are automatically forwarded by SMS and e-mail to relevant people.

The Armadillo has a NiMH backup battery – essential for high-risk operations where sending a panic alarm should not be dependent on vehicle power.

MESSAGING AND NAVIGATION

A optional fitted PDA allows 2-way text messaging (independent of GSM

coverage), in addition to providing onboard GPS navigation.
