Case Study Oil & Gas Security – Indonesia

Overview

A global producer of oil and gas with facilities in Indonesia engaged our consultant to conduct a risk review of their onshore and offshore facilities. The client's intent was to validate and reinforce, where necessary, their contingency plans during a time of increasing instability in Indonesia.

The Challenge

The client's assets were spread onshore and offshore from Batam Island to East Java. Added to this geographical challenge, the review with recommendations was to be presented to the national board within two weeks, to allow for budgeting and planning to be carried by the Head Office in the US.

The Process

Utilizing two teams, one for onshore, one for offshore, the methodology of AS4360 was adopted. This ensured consistency of reporting and of conclusions to be drawn. Further, teams reported on ISPS compliance where appropriate.

Assets reviewed included:

- Onshore exploration rigs and sites
- Offshore production platforms
- Offshore supply bases
- Air terminals and cargo handling vetting and security
- Maritime terminals
- Downstream facilities

A significant aspect of the review was an examination of existing practices and procedures, including community and law enforcement liaison practices. This proved to be a significant factor in being able to assess the success or otherwise of the client in engaging all available resources to protect their maritime and land based assets. This was particularly true of their extant contingency plans.

The Result

The Consultants produced a comprehensive risk analysis report which recommended feasible, practical and cost effective mitigation strategies for threats and risks. These were endorsed by the Board and forwarded for consideration to Global management
